3


4 4. The statements obtained by Mr. Breen refute these allegations and
5 are relevant to the defendants' good faith and lack of intent to
6 fraud.

8 5. These witnesses reside in Liberia, and are beyond the jurisdiction
9 of the court. While they have indicated a willingness to appear as
10 witnesses for trial, the defendants cannot be assured that they will
11 appear.

12 6. It is therefore requested that the court order that these witnesses be
13 deposed to preserve their testimony.
